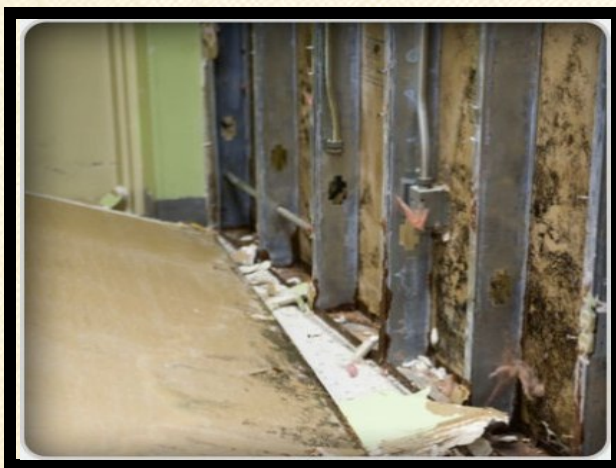




## Mold Inspections:
