

SAFETY TIP

Know your pH – On the surface, it's a simple numerical scale, 0 - 14, but it has important implications, both for the safe handling of substances and how they are regulated by federal statutes. A Ph of 7 is considered neutral, while readings above and below that are considered basic and acidic, respectively. When a substance is either measured at or less than 2, or at or above 12.5, it is considered hazardous/corrosive according to the EPA-RCRA Waste Hazardous Identification characteristics.
