#### Safety Tip:

Lightning storms can be a common occurrence this time of year, so it's wise to maintain proper safety habits in the event of a storm. If outdoors, avoid high ground, water, and open spaces. Metal objects, including fences. wires. and machinery, should also be avoided. If indoors, stay away from water, doors, and windows. Appliances such as computers and power tools should be unplugged in case of a power surge. If someone is injured, CPR should be administered by a qualified person while help is on the way.
