Georgia Hazardous Site Response Act Enacted Amendments

SEPTEMBER 2014

On August 26, 2014 the Georgia Environmental Protection Division amended the Hazardous Site Response Rule Chapter 391-3-19. The key changes include:

- Allows GAEPD to grant waivers to Hazardous Waste Fees for Pollution Prevention.
- Brownfield properties undergoing clean up are not required to report newly discovered releases in the soil.
- Allows the de-listing of sites that comply with a Type 5 risk reduction standard upon execution of a Uniform Environmental Covenant.
- Alternative notification standards for groundwater releases using MCLs.
- 90-day deferment of RQSM scoring versus original 30day.
- Delineation of soils to Residential RSLs versus background.
- Delineation of groundwater to Media Target Concentrations (MCLs).
- Removes requirement for public notice to be placed in newspaper.

If you have a site that is currently affected by the Hazardous Site Response Act or may be in the future, let MEI evaluate your situation and try and find solutions for your problems.
